Attending the Trans Tasman Principals Conference - 'Together Leading Learning'

This week I have been attending the Trans Tasman Principals conference in Christchurch along with nearly 1000 primary principals from across New Zealand and Australia. Today we heard addresses from the Australian Federal Minister of

Education, and the New Zealand Minister. Interestingly, both countries are experiencing similar challenges, especially with concerns about declining student attendance figures, lower achievement results in Mathematics and Reading, and concerns about declining standards of student behaviour. Both countries are also promoting policies about a more structured approach to teaching reading and Mathematics.

Attending the conference provides principals an opportunity to connect with other principals, and to listen to inspiring and challenging keynote speeches. It also promotes a sense of pride in leadership and in our schools. I plan to bring knowledge and ideas to implement at Tirimoana in 2025. Mrs Hammond and Mrs Matthews have accompanied me to this conference.

Te Wiki o te Reo Māori is an annual celebration for all New Zealanders to show their support for the Māori language. The theme for Te Wiki 2024 is 'Ake ake ake – A Forever Language'. It represents the resilience, adaptability and endurance of our language. It also reflects the
