Welcome to school, and welcome back to school for the start of the 2025 school year. The school year started with our Smart Start to School on Monday 3rd Feb to enable parents and children to meet their 2025 teacher, to 'break the ice' for the return to school, and to share some information about the class and the year ahead. This was another successful day with around 80% of our students attending. It's wonderful to see our tamariki back, engaged, and ready for a great year of learning. Both teachers and parents have noticed how this

day helped students feel confident and settle smoothly and quickly into their 2025 classrooms. Staff have worked hard over January to get the grounds looking great and to create warm and inviting classrooms, setting the stage for an exciting year of learning.

So far this year we have welcomed 27 year 1 students and another 21 students across other year levels. We start the 2025 school year with 637 Students.

Requirements from the Ministry of Education to be implemented in all primary schools in 2025

Our teachers are ready to implement the new curriculums and assessment requirements. We are taking active steps to ensure our students are ready. Assessment is not new to primary schools, our school already uses the required ministry assessment tools to gather data in years 4-6. These assessment tools have now been extended to Year 3.



During week 4 (24-28 February)- students in Years 3-6 will be working through these assessments. Your child does not need to worry, their teachers will be supporting them with the administration of these assessments.





Student attendance continues to be a major focus for school and the Minisity in 2025.

Our focus continues for all students to attend school for at least 90% of the school year.

90% attendance means no more than 5 days absence across a 10 week term.

We are asking you to:

If your child is going to be absent from school you should let the school know as soon as possible.

You need to let us know why your child is away and for how long.

You can contact us via the school app, email or phone call.

What school is doing:

Your child's safety and wellbeing is a priority for the school. If your child doesn't turn up to school we will be concerned for their safety.

If the school doesn't hear from you, we will get in touch with you to make sure your child is okay.

If your child is away for more than 3 days without you contacting us, the classroom teacher will contact you to see how your child is doing.

If there are repeated absences, the classroom teacher will also make contact with you to enquire about your child.

What the Ministry of Education is doing:

Daily attendance is automatically submitted to the Ministry at the end of each school day. This is analysed and a data quality report is sent to school every 2 weeks.



You can choose to wear your own cultural dress or one from a culture you have a connection with, or you can choose to wear home clothes that show you are a kiwi kid.














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
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
